MOOSEHEART BABY VILLAGE – A CHILDRENS WORLD



A highlight of any tour of Mooseheart is to visit the Pennsylvania Baby Village. Boys and girls ranging from infancy through age four make their home in surroundings specially designed for their comfort and security. Here, chairs, tables, beds and chests, to the four diminutive commodes in each hall, have been made to accommodate the short legs and small bodies of the children.

The interiors of the four buildings have a nursery theme, with soft carpeting on the floors and lower walls to cushion uncertain toddler steps. Thanks to the Pennsylvania Moose Association and the Women of the Moose, all four halls were renovated in the 1990's. The four homes are named after rivers in Pennsylvania, Susquehanna, Schuylkill, Juniata and Allegheny.

Each hall has its own television set and VCR, and there are toys, dolls, stuffed animals and children's books throughout. In nice weather the children play in the sandboxes and heart-shaped wading pool, On the swings and other playground equipment, ride their tricycles and wagons, and engage in games and contests.

The three and four year olds attend nursery school located in a fifth building right in the Village. At age five, they attend kindergarten, and at age six they begin first grade.

Each child has his or her own individual youth-sized bed, with cribs for the youngest. Each child has his or her own drawer, hanger space and "cubby hole" where personal toys and books are kept.

Baby Village was dedicated on August 22, 1922. The five buildings are one-story structures of concrete blocks with red tile roofs. They are arranged in the form of a heart.

Tours are available to all members, all you have to do is attend Illinois Day at Mooseheart in September or call Mooseheart and set up a time for a guided tour. You won't regret it. This is what we are all about, we can support Mooseheart and Moosehaven at the same time have the socializing and fellowship our Lodge offers.

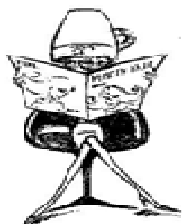
